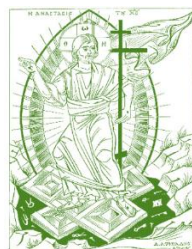

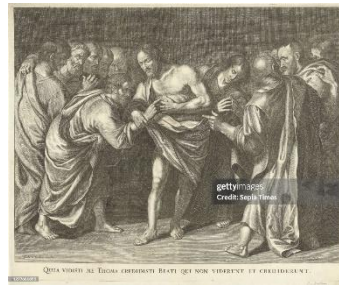
It is the Day of Resurrection!

Bestowing life to those in the tombs.’”



Jesus' Appearance to Thomas

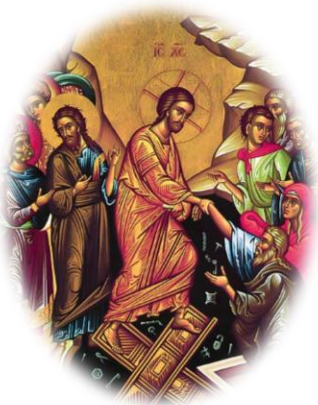
Thomas' skepticism about Jesus' first appearance to the disciples sets the stage for His next appearance eight days later. (If we count the days of Pascha, today is the eighth day – see how the Church relives the events of the Gospel.) The Gospel of John mentions that Thomas is called the Twin, perhaps because he was prone to be of two minds – a doubter by nature which made him excessively inquisitive. Like so many of our time, Thomas does not trust the accounts of the other disciples or the Myrrh-bearing women. For him to believe that Jesus has appeared to others and is risen from the dead, he will need multiple proofs. He will need to see Jesus with his own eyes, he will touch with his own hands the print of the nails, and he must hear with his own ears the voice of his master.

On the Eighth Day of Pascha, Jesus again appears to His disciples. This time Thomas is in their company. Jesus does not rebuke Thomas to speak but He is ready to offer him the gift he has desperately been seeking. Our Lord approaches Thomas offering him the proof that he has requested. See how our Lord to Thomas' demand using his own words. First the Lord rebukes Thomas by saying, "reach out with your finger and touch my hands and side." Thomas must have questioned how the Lord knew what he said. This, in and of itself, should have proven the Resurrection to him. Jesus then admonished him saying, "Do not be unbelieving but believing."

Our Lord comes to Thomas for the exact same reason He comes near to us – to inspire faith. Can we react and be as bold as Thomas who after touching the Lord exclaims with conviction, "My Lord and my God!" See how Thomas becomes a great theologian as his faith in Christ is confessed. See how, if we move away from demanding physical proof and use faith as a basis how the Word becomes alive within us. The Gospel message and faith in Christ is impossible for anyone who demands physical proof. The disciples spread the Gospel because they did not seek after miracles but relied on God's word alone. Our Lord blesses those who reach faith with only trust in the witness of the Word. This is why our Lord says, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

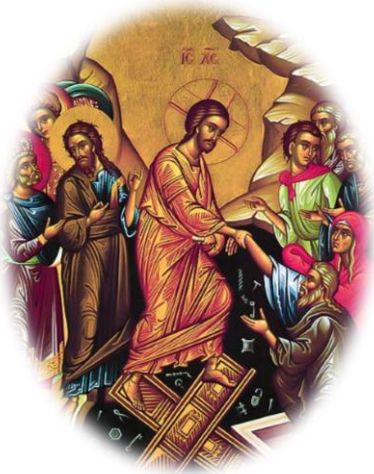

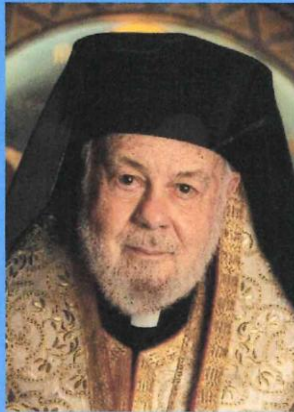

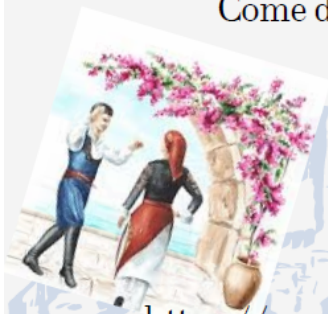
