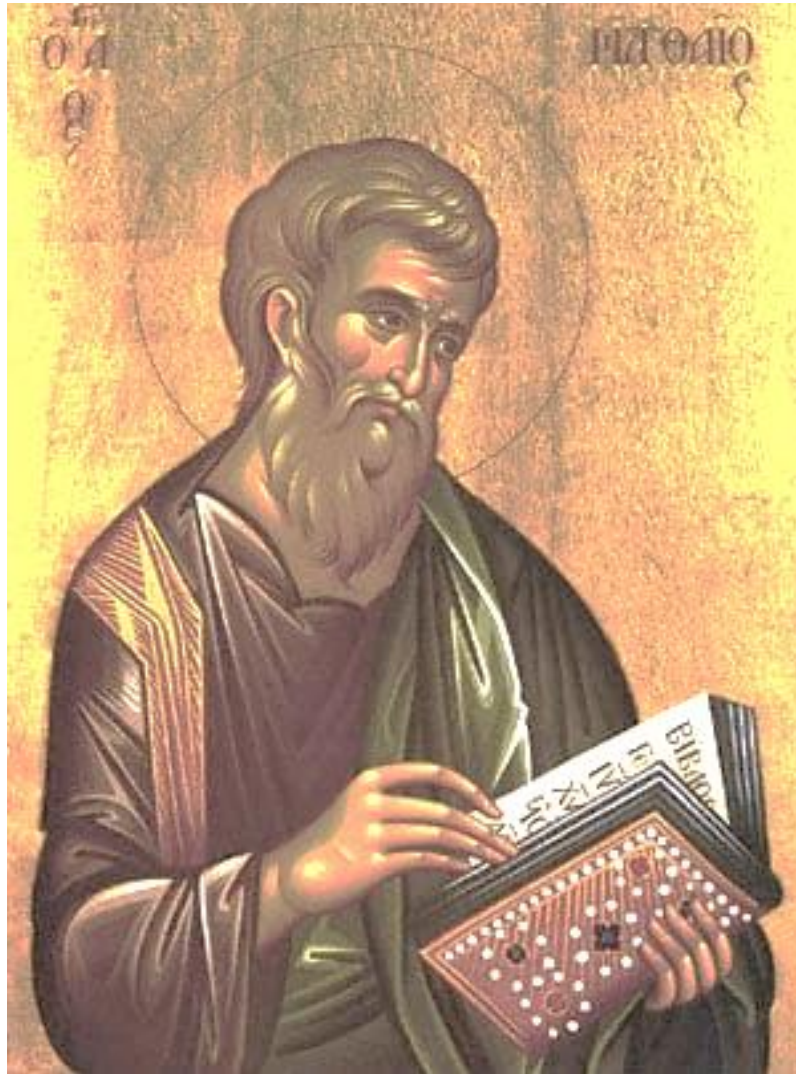

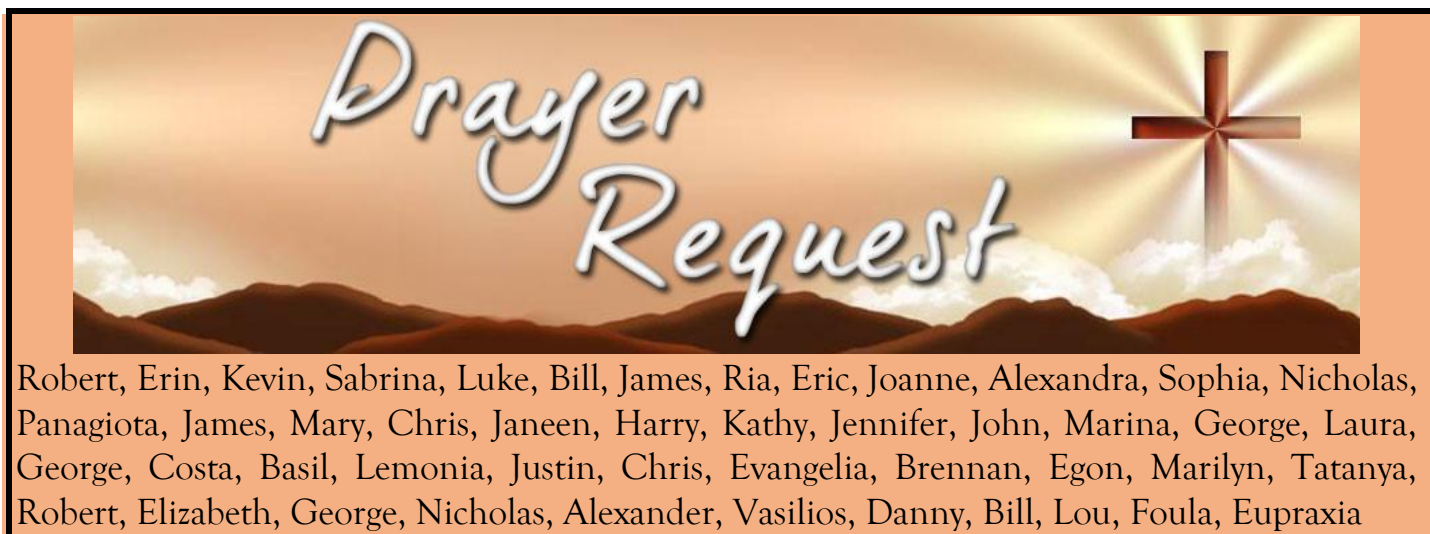

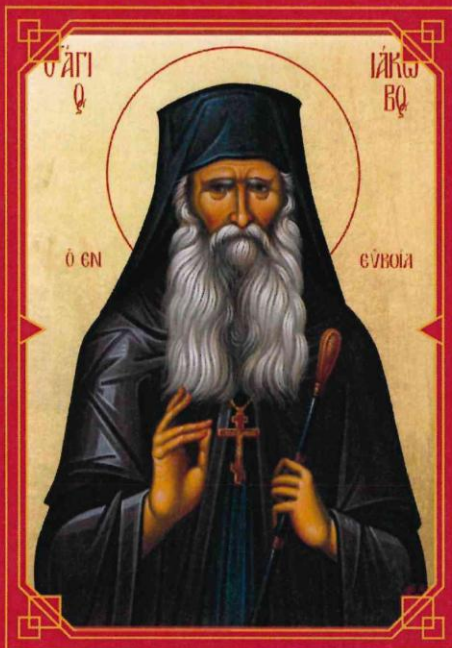

St. Matthew the Apostle and Evangelist – November 16

St. Matthew the Apostle and Evangelist, who was also called Levi, was the son of Alphaeus and had Galilee as his homeland. St. Matthew is recognized as an apostle and evangelist in the Orthodox Church, known for leaving his tax-collector life in Capernaum to follow Jesus. He repaid those he had cheated by giving his possessions to the poor after his conversion. He is the patron saint of tax collectors and bankers. He is also known for writing the Gospel of Matthew which chronicles Jesus' birth, ministry, death, and resurrection. As one of the Twelve Apostles, he preached the Gospel to the "lost sheep of the house of Israel" and witnessed the Savior's life firsthand.

While still in Palestine, he wrote his Gospel first in Hebrew, being also the first of all to write the Gospel. When he is depicted in icons, there is portrayed next to him the likeness of a man, one of the symbolic living creatures mentioned by Ezekiel (1.10), which, as Saint Irenaeus writes, is a symbol of our Saviour's Incarnation.

Tradition holds that he preached in Judea for a period after Jesus' Ascension before traveling to places like Persia and Ethiopia. He is also associated with missionary work in Judea, Persia, and Ethiopia. He is believed to have died as a martyr.

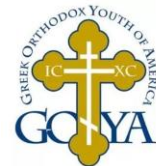

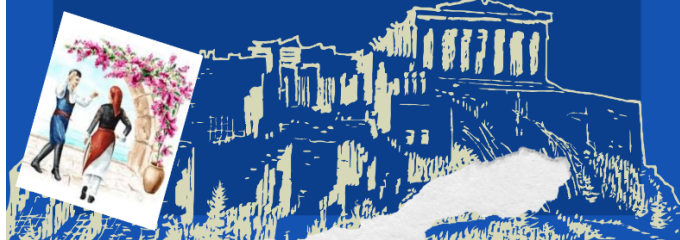
